Accountable Health Partners Population Health Initiatives Awards

Overview:

The goal of this program is to stimulate "grassroots" initiatives from across the AHP network of community and employed providers aimed at improving performance in one of four key areas:

- 1) The health of our population
- 2) Performance on value based metrics (see attached current list of metrics)
- 3) Achieve reduction in costs of care provision.
- 4) Improve provider satisfaction and ease of care delivery for providers

The hope is to foster programs that may become self-sustaining or which serve as demonstration programs for larger initiatives.

Applications:

The outline below is meant to provide a concise description of the proposed initiative and requested funding. It is important to note that these funds are not intended to provide research support and proposals will be scored adversely if they include requests for salary support or new hires without evidence of sustainability or support from a clinical department or entity. It is expected that all funded proposals will demonstrate improvement in one of the four areas noted above.

High quality applications may be asked to provide additional documentation and/or meet with our review team to discuss enhancing or implementing the proposed initiative.

We anticipate most grant awards will be for initiatives within the \$25,000-\$50,000 range, but we have placed no predetermined cap on proposals we will consider.

Submission:

An initial two-page application responding to the outlined questions is due by Monday, September 25, 2018 and to be submitted as a single PDF. These applications will be reviewed and scored by a team of senior leadership from within AHP and its network of providers. We anticipate the first round of funding will be distributed on or before December 2018.
