



AHP-BHI ECHO® PROJECT ACROSS THE LIFESPAN.

The Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes in General Psychiatry (ECHO® PSYCH) for AHP is a telementoring and educational program for primary care clinicians including physicians, APPs, RNs, social workers, PAOs in area hospitals and care managers. The format is for clinicians (the spokes) from different practices in the AHP network to log in via a teleconferencing platform (ZOOM) and present cases with varied levels of complexity. Members of the AHP behavioral health integration team as well as care managers and pharmacists (the hub) will engage in discussion with the clinician presenting the case and allow for discussion and feedback from others on the call as well. During such discussion, several recommendations are made from a multidisciplinary perspective. The session which typically lasts one hour will also include a short didactic presentation tied to the case being discussed. The AHP-BHI ECHO® is a program sponsored and funded by Accountable Health Partners (AHP).
