

COVID-19 Daily Update

In order to provide updates on the evolving response and best practices in regards to the COVID-19 pandemic, AHP will be delivering brief, critical updates on an ongoing basis addressing important highlights and frequently asked questions.

Daily COVID-19 Response Call

Urgent Surgical Cases

As reported in a recent call, urgent UR Medicine surgical cases in the Rochester-area will be performed at Highland Hospital. Today we learned that urgent surgical cases for patients age 15 and younger will not be performed at Highland: those surgeries will remain at the Golisano Children's Hospital.

Testing Guidance

We encourage providers to perform any Covid testing of patients that is specifically requested by their local health department, regardless of the patient's clinical status compared to the testing criteria laid out in the [Covid Testing Flowchart](#). Testing of patients (who would not otherwise meet testing criteria) at the health department's request will support disease tracking and tracing efforts.

Other than that nuance, there are no changes to our recommendation for testing: advise stable febrile patients with flu-like symptoms to remain at home in self-quarantine following the isolation guidelines [here](#); do not test or refer for testing. Testing Results Reporting

We received an update from UR Medicine Labs indicating that Covid test results will be released to MyChart where patients may view them a day after being resulted. Additional information concerns Covid testing for inpatients who are discharged while their results are still pending: hospital discharge coordinators will communicate to the PCP office in the course of the warm handoff process that the patient has a pending Covid test, after which the PCP office assumes responsibility to follow up on those results and communicate with the patient.
