New COVID Testing Guidance

In collaboration with UR Medicine, AHP is updating its COVID testing guidance to community providers. In addition to testing for healthcare workers and long term care residents, providers may consider testing symptomatic essential workers (e.g., restaurant, transit, grocery store workers) and any moderately symptomatic (febrile, cough, shortness of breath) patients. We are working on revising the COVID Testing Flowchart to reflect this new guidance, and we will share that information when it is complete. Testing reagent and supplies remain limited, so should collection outstrip testing capacity, this guidance may be revised.

Emotional Support/Resources Hotline for AHP Providers, Staff and Families

Staffed by over 80 volunteer clinicians from URMC, an Emotional Support/Resources Hotline is now up and running to help you and your families navigate these challenging times. In addition to UR Medicine faculty and staff, AHP providers and all family members can access this free, anonymous and confidential service by calling **(585) 276-3100.** The line is open seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. — hours chosen to cover typical health care worker shifts. The line will automatically roll over to 211 after hours.

Hotline volunteers provide guidance and support on a wide range of personal and professional concerns, including anxiety and stress management, housing, finances, food needs and child care. They can also connect callers with a variety of helpful resources. Callers will not be asked to provide their name, and no information about your call will be shared with anyone. Please note that this is not a mental health crisis line; if you need to access a mental health crisis support, you or your patients can call 275-8686.

MEDENT Video Visits Available At No Charge in May
