

WELL-CHILD (15mo, 6+) (2020 MEASURE v7.30.2020)

DESCRIPTION

The percentage of patients who turned 15 months old during the measurement year and had the required number of well-child visits with a PCP.

CHANGES

- All active patients now qualify for the measure. A patient no longer needs an encounter within the measurement period to be eligible.
- Visits on the 15th month birthday DO NOT count.
- Telehealth visit is excluded as a qualifying well-child visit. Visits billed with a telehealth modifier or billed with a telehealth POS code will not be counted
- Well-child visits must now be performed by a provider with one of the following specialties: Family Medicine, Family Practice, General Internal Medicine, General Pediatrics, General Practice, Geriatrics, Internal Medicine, OBGYN, Obstetrics & Gynecology, PCP, Pediatrics
Where last year all well-child visits counted no matter the provider's specialty.
- An exclusion was added for a patient in hospice care.

QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

- Patient turned 15 months old during the period.

SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

One of the following is needed:

- Patient had 6 or more well-child visits with a PCP during the first 15 months of their life that were NOT conducted with telehealth. (Visits on the 15th month birthday DO NOT count.)

EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient has evidence of hospice during the measurement period.

INCLUSION CRITERIA

- All active patients.
