

WELL-CHILD (3 - 6 YEAR) (2020 MEASURE v7.30.2020)

DESCRIPTION

The percentage of patients 3-6 years of age who had one or more well-child visits with a PCP.

CHANGES

- All active patients now qualify for the measure. A patient no longer needs an encounter within the measurement period to be eligible.
- Telehealth visits were removed as a qualifying well-child visit. Visits billed with a telehealth modifier or billed with a telehealth POS code will not be counted.
- Handouts given during a visit without evidence of a discussion does not meet criteria for Health Education/Anticipatory Guidance
- Well-child visits must now be performed by a provider with one of the following specialties: Family Medicine, Family Practice, General Internal Medicine, General Pediatrics, General Practice, Geriatrics, Internal Medicine, OBGYN, Obstetrics & Gynecology, PCP, Pediatrics
Where last year all well-child visits counted no matter the provider's specialty.
- An exclusion was added for a patient in hospice care

QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

- Patient age between 3 and 6 on the period end date.

SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

- Patient had 1 or more well-child visits with a PCP during the year before the period end date. The well-child visits were NOT telehealth.

EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient was admitted to hospice within measurement period.

INCLUSION CRITERIA

- All active patients.
