

## Fall Risk Management (2021 MEASURE v5.26.2021)

### DESCRIPTION

Percentage of patients 65 years of age or older who had a fall or had problems with balance or walking in the past 12 months, who were seen by a practitioner in the Measurement Period and who received fall risk intervention.

### QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

- Patient is 65 years of age or older as of the first day of the Measurement Period.

**AND**

- Patient had one or more medical encounters in the three years prior to the Measure Period end date.

**AND**

- Patient had fall or problem with balance within the Measurement Period.

### SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

- Patient has Fall Plan of Care documented during 12 months before period end.

**OR**

- Patient had a physical therapy encounter during the 12 months before period end.

**OR**

- Patient had Vitamin D Supplementation during the 12 months before period end. Vitamin D is being taken from the 'Active Medication List' within the EMR (it does not require a prescription dispensing event).

**OR**

- Patient had Balance/Gait Training during the 12 months before period end

### EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient did NOT have a Fall Plan of Care documented during measurement period for Medical or Other reasons.

Value Set: CPT II 0518F with 1P, CPT II 0518F with 8P

### INCLUSION CRITERIA

- All active patients.
