What is ECHO Autism & DD?

- A virtual learning network of medical providers
- Real-time access to experts in autism and other developmental disorders
- An innovative system that allows professionals to:
 - Increase confidence in identifying developmental disorders, and referring to appropriate services
 - Expand knowledge on diagnosis and treatment of co-occurring medical and behavioral conditions

How will ECHO Autism & DD help me?

- Regular, convenient access to University of Rochester experts:
 - Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrics Specialist
 - Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner
 - Clinical Psychologist
 - Registered Dietitian
 - Social Worker
 - Parent Advocate/Educator
- Increase skills and knowledge using case-based learning about:
 - Evidence-based practices for screening and diagnosis of developmental disorders
 - Screening and diagnosis of behavioral and mental health disorders in children with developmental disorders
 - Medical and non-medical treatments for challenging behaviors

How does it work?

- Members of pediatric & family medicine primary care teams (MD, NP, SW, PA, care managers and others) meet virtually with the University of Rochester hub team
- Discuss complex cases in YOUR practice for real-time advice from experts
- Participants receive free CME & SWK CEU
- Meetings occur for 1 hour, 2 x month (2nd and 4th Fridays, 12-1pm) starting on October 8

What do I need to get started?

- Internet access
- A front-facing camera on a smartphone, tablet, or computer/webcam



Why should ECHO Autism & DD matter to you?

- 1 in 59 children have autism
- 50-80% have trouble with sleep
- 40-80% have GI issues
- More than 50% have co-occurring anxiety or ADHD
- Parents need medical support in their home communities
