<a href="#">Comprehensive Diabetes Care: HbA1c &lt; 8.0</a>	The percentage of patients 18–75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) whose most recent HbA1c in the measurement year was <8.0%.		10
<a href="#">Comprehensive Diabetes Care: Eye Exam</a>	The percentage of patients 18–75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had a retinal exam or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional in the measurement year, a negative retinal or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional in the measurement year or year prior, or bilateral eye enucleation.		10
<a href="#">Controlling High Blood Pressure</a>	The percentage of patients 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension and whose BP was adequately controlled to <140/90 during the measurement year.		10
<a href="#">Breast Cancer Screening</a>	The percentage of women 50–74 years of age who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer.		10
<a href="#">Colorectal Cancer Screening</a>	The percentage of adults 50–75 years of age who had appropriate screening for colorectal cancer.		10
<a href="#">Childhood Immunization Status Combo 3</a>	Percentage of children 2 years of age who had 4 DTaP, 3 IPV, 3 HIB, 3 Hep B, 1 MMR, 1 VZV, and 4 pneumococcal conjugate vaccines by their 2nd birthday		10
<a href="#">Immunizations for Adolescents Combo 2</a>	Percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who had 1 meningococcal vaccine, 2-3 HPV, and 1 Tdap by their 13th birthday.		10
Well Care Visits in the First 30 Months of Life	<p>The percentage of members who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during the last 15 months:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <a href="#">Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months</a>: Children who turned 15 months old during the measurement year and had 6 or more well-child visits on or before the 15-month birthday.</li> <li>- <a href="#">Well Child Visits for Age 15 Months -30 Months</a>: Children who turned 30 months old during the measurement year and had 2 or more well-child visits between the child's 15-month birthday plus 1 day and the 30-month birthday.</li> </ul> <p><b>(2 separate numerators - each numerator reported and scored individually with measure points equally divided between the 2 numerators)</b></p>	First 15 months: 6+ visits	10

<a href="#">Fall Risk Management</a>	Percentage of patients 65 years of age or older who had a fall or had problems with balance or walking in the past 12 months, who were seen by a practitioner in the past 12 months and who received a recommendation for how to prevent falls or treat problems with balance or walking from their current practitioner.		10
