Comprehensive Diabetes Care: HbA1c < 8.0	The percentage of patients 18–75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) whose most recent HbA1c in the measurement year was <8.0%.		10
Comprehensive Diabetes Care: Eye Exam	The percentage of patients 18–75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had a retinal exam or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional in the measurement year, a negative retinal or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional in the measurement year or year prior, or bilateral eye enucleation.		10
Controlling High Blood Pressure	The percentage of patients 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension and whose BP was adequately controlled to <140/90 during the measurement year.		10
Breast Cancer Screening	The percentage of women 50–74 years of age who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer.		10
Colorectal Cancer Screening	The percentage of adults 50–75 years of age who had appropriate screening for colorectal cancer.		10
Childhood Immunization Status Combo 3	Percentage of children 2 years of age who had 4 DTaP, 3 IPV, 3 Hib, 3 Hep B, 1 MMR, 1 VZV, and 4 pneumococcal conjugate vaccines by their 2nd birthday		10
Immunizations for Adolescents Combo 2	Percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who had 1 meningococcal vaccine, 2-3 HPV, and 1 Tdap by their 13th birthday.		10
Well Care Visits in the First 30 Months of Life	<p>The percentage of members who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during the last 15 months:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months: Children who turned 15 months old during the measurement year and had 6 or more well-child visits on or before the 15-month birthday. - Well Child Visits for Age 15 Months -30 Months: Children who turned 30 months old during the measurement year and had 2 or more well-child visits between the child's 15-month birthday plus 1 day and the 30-month birthday. <p>(2 separate numerators - each numerator reported and scored individually with measure points equally divided between the 2 numerators)</p>	First 15 months: 6+ visits	10

Fall Risk Management	Percentage of patients 65 years of age or older who had a fall or had problems with balance or walking in the past 12 months, who were seen by a practitioner in the past 12 months and who received a recommendation for how to prevent falls or treat problems with balance or walking from their current practitioner.		10
