

DEPRESSION SCREENING (2021 MEASURE v6.21.2021) -

DESCRIPTION

The percentage of patients 12 years of age and older who were screened for clinical depression using a standardized instrument.

QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

Patients 12 years of age and older at the start of the Measurement Period.

SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

• Patient with a documented result of a depression screening performed using an age-appropriate standardized instrument between January 1 and December 1 of the Measurement Period

EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient with depression that starts during the year prior to the Measurement Period.
 - OR
- Patient with bipolar disorder in the year prior to the measurement period.
 - OR
- Patient has a medical reason for not having a depression screening documented during 1 year before period end.
 - OR
- Patient refused a depression screening during 1 year before period end.
- OR
- Patient is in hospice or using hospice services during the Measurement Period.

INCLUSION CRITERIA

All active patients.
