- Lack of insurance
- · Diapers, formula, infant care items
- Dental care
- Basic referrals for developmental evaluation
- Basic connectivity to behavioral health and/or substance abuse counseling
- · Complex transportation issues only

WHY

Social drivers of health (SDOH) impact access to routine health and preventative care in our community. Early identification and screening for SDOH is critical in allowing for early referral and intervention with high-risk populations.

• Your SW CM will remain the primary receiver of your referrals, and your referral process will not change.

HOW

- Your SW CM will work with Brianna and Meghan as needed to address a family's basic needs.
- Outreach notes will be faxed securely to the practice via Right Fax OR Meghan and Brianna will document their work within the practice EMR.
