Immunizations for All?

WHO: Nationally, > 1 in 6 children do not complete their childhood vaccine series. Hispanic and Black children being less likely than White children.

~ Globally, in 2023, there were 14.5 million 'zero-dose' children, who received no vaccines (World Health Organization).

WHY: A child's likelihood for completing their vaccine series is impacted by geographic location (rural vs. urban), socioeconomic status, and race & ethnicity.

~ Both historical and current experiences of discrimination impact trust of medical systems which extends to vaccinations (Center for Disease Control and Prevention).
