

# COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING (2024 MEASURE v01.22.2024)

## DESCRIPTION

Percent of patients 45 - 75 years of age with one or more screenings for colorectal cancer.

## CHANGES

- Added a required exclusion for patients who died during the measurement year.

## QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

- Patient is 46 - 75 on the period end date

## TARGETS

Percentile	2024 Threshold	Change from 2023

75 <sup>TH</sup>	62.29%	-6.29%
50 <sup>TH</sup>	56.93%	-6.47%

## SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

### One of the following is needed:

- Patient had an FOBT during the measurement year.
- Patient had a flexible sigmoidoscopy during the 5 years before period end.
- Patient had a colonoscopy during the 10 years before period end.
- Patient had a CT Colonography during the 5 years before period end.
- Patient had a Stool DNA with FIT test during the 3 years before periods end.

## EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient receiving palliative care or hospice.  
**OR**
- Patient had colon cancer before period end.  
**OR**
- Patient had a total colectomy before period end.  
**OR**
- Patient who had died during the measurement year  
**OR**
- Patient is 66 or older at the end of the measurement period and is:
  - enrolled in an I-SNP any time during 1 year before period end  
**OR**
  - has evidence of advanced illness and frailty during 1 year before period end  
**OR**
  - is living long-term in an institution (LTI Flag) during the two years before period end

## INCLUSION CRITERIA

- All active patients.
