

DM EYE EXAM (2024 MEASURE v01.18.2024)

DESCRIPTION

The percentage of patients 18 to 75 years of age with type 1 or type 2 diabetes who had a retinal eye exam performed.

TARGETS Percentile 2024 Threshold Change from 2023 90TH 64.23% -0.07% 75TH 57.66% +1.18% 50TH 50.12% +0.73% 25TH 43.07% +0.49%

CHANGES

Added a required exclusion for patients who died during the measurement year.

QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

• 18-75 years old at measurement period end

AND

• At least two valid outpatient, observation, telephone or online visits or non-acute inpatient encounters/discharges with a diagnosis of diabetes during the measurement period or the year prior.

OR

One acute inpatient encounter or discharge with a diagnosis of diabetes during the measurement period or year prior - not including telehealth.

OR

• A prescription for a diabetes medication during the measurement period or the year prior.

SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

One of the following is needed:

- A retinal exam with an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist) during 12 months before measurement period end
- A negative retinal or dilated eye exam with an eye care professional during 24 months before measurement period end. A diagnosis of diabetes mellitus without complications is sufficient for proving the result of a retinal exam was negative, as long as that exam was conducted by an eye care professional.
- Bilateral eye enucleation starts before period end
- Two unilateral eye enucleations start before period end with at least 14 days between the two events
- Left AND Right unilateral eye enucleation recorded before period end.

EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

Patient has no diagnosis of diabetes during two years prior to period end

OR

Patient had a diagnosis of polycystic ovarian syndrome, gestational diabetes or steroid-induced diabetes, in any setting, during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year

OR

Patient has evidence of Palliative care or hospice during the measurement period

OR

Patient who died during the measurement year

OR

- Patient is 66 or older at the end of the measurement period and is:
 - o enrolled in an I-SNP any time during 1 year before period end

OR

o has evidence of advanced illness and frailty during 1 year before period end

OR

o is living long-term in an institution (LTI Flag) during the two years before period end

INCLUSION CRITERIA

All active patients.
