#### **Health Highlight**

Autism (ASD)

WHO: 1 in 36 children in the United States are diagnosed with Autism. Boys are 4 times more likely than girls to be given an Autism diagnosis at a 4:1 ratio out of 100 children. Autism is less prevalent in white children than other racial and ethnic groups. In addition, 1 in 45 adults carry an Autism diagnosis. While diagnosis is most common in childhood, it is worth noting that symptoms are sometimes missed leading to a later in life diagnosis and therefore missed opportunities for lifelong supports.

WHAT: Autism "refers to a broad range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech and nonverbal communication... Autism looks different for everyone, and each person with autism has a distinct set of strengths and challenges"

**WHY:** There is not one cause that leads to an Autism diagnosis, but there are many factors that increase risk. Evidence shows that children with a sibling who have ASD, genetic conditions, birth complications and maternal age all increase risk.
