

Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients With Diabetes

(2025 MEASURE v04.01.2025)

DESCRIPTION

The percentage of patients 18 to 75 years of age with type 1 or type 2 diabetes whose most recent glycemic status (hemoglobin A1c [HbA1c] or glucose management indicator [GMI]) was < 8.0%.

CHANGES

- Measure name change from Hemoglobin A1c Control for Patients With Diabetes.
- Glucose management indicator added as an option to meet numerator criteria

QUALIFICATION (Denominator)

- 18-75 years old at measurement period end
- AND
- At least two valid outpatient, observation, telephone or online visits or non-acute inpatient encounters/discharges with a diagnosis of diabetes during the measurement period or year prior.
- OR
- One acute inpatient encounter or discharge with a diagnosis of diabetes during the measurement period or year prior - not including telehealth.
- OR
- Were dispensed insulin or hypoglycemics/ antihyperglycemics during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year.
- AND
- Have at least one diagnosis of diabetes during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year.

SATISFYING THE MEASURE (Numerator)

- The most recent HbA1c or GMI result during 12 months before measurement period end is less than 8%.
- Note: If there are multiple glycemic status assessments on the same date of service, use the lowest result

EXCLUSIONS / EXCEPTIONS

- Patient has no diagnosis of diabetes in the measurement period or the year prior
- OR
- Patient had a diagnosis of polycystic ovarian syndrome, gestational diabetes or steroid-induced diabetes, in any setting, during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year
- OR
- Patient who died during the measurement year
- OR
- Patient has evidence of Palliative care or hospice during the measurement period
- OR
- Patient is 66 or older at the end of the measurement period and is:
  - enrolled in an I-SNP any time during 1 year before period end
  - OR
  - has evidence of advanced illness or frailty during 1 year before period end
  - OR
  - is living long-term in an institution (LTI Flag) during the two years before period end

INCLUSION CRITERIA

- All active patients.
